



## *Resolution of Appreciation*

*W* **HEREAS**, Mr. Quillen was appointed as vice chair of the Efficiency, Effectiveness, and Accountability Committee in 2007, chair of the Efficiency, Effectiveness, and Accountability Committee in 2008, and chair of the Academic Affairs and Curriculum Committee in 2009; and

*W* **HEREAS**, Mr. Quillen demonstrated commitment to excellence through his advocacy and service to the Commonwealth, the KCTCS Board of Regents, and the Kentucky Community and Technical College System; and

*W* **HEREAS**, Mr. Quillen strived to create and maintain the highest level of quality public accountability, providing input on policies that create and maintain the highest level of quality, public accountability, institutional effectiveness pertaining to finance, facilities, construction, human resources, strategic plan measurement, academic and technical program offerings, and online course offerings; and

*W* **HEREAS**, the Kentucky Community and Technical College System Board of Regents wishes to express its heartfelt appreciation to Mr. Quillen as he leaves the KCTCS Board of Regents;
