Background

In 1960, the University of Kentucky, a public land grant institution, established the Northwest Extension Campus in Henderson, Kentucky. In 1962, the Kentucky General Assembly authorized the formation of a statewide system of community colleges to be operated by the University of Kentucky (UK). The University of Kentucky Community College System (UKCCS) was established in 1964, and the Northwest Extension was renamed Henderson Community College and became one of the seven charter institutions.

In 1997, the *Kentucky Postsecondary Education Improvement Act* was enacted. This law created the Kentucky Community and Technical College System (KCTCS). This new system operates under a Board of Regents charged with the operation and management of the System's two branches: Technical Colleges and the Community Colleges. The day-to-day management responsibilities of the UK Community College System were transferred to the KCTCS on January 14, 1998.

The mission of Henderson Community College is to:

- Provide general education curriculum for the first two years of a baccalaureate program (Associate in Arts and Associate in Science degrees).
- Offer career-oriented programs to prepare students for immediate technical or paraprofessional employment (Certificates, Diplomas, or Associate in Applied Science degrees).
